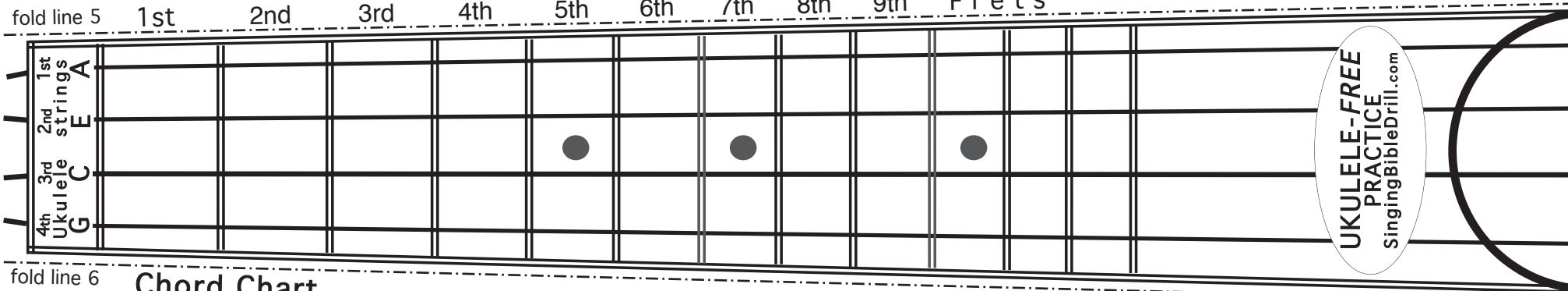
\*Hint - To remember ukulele strings: **GCEA** Give Children Every Advantage

 You will be developing *muscle memory* as you practice on paper.

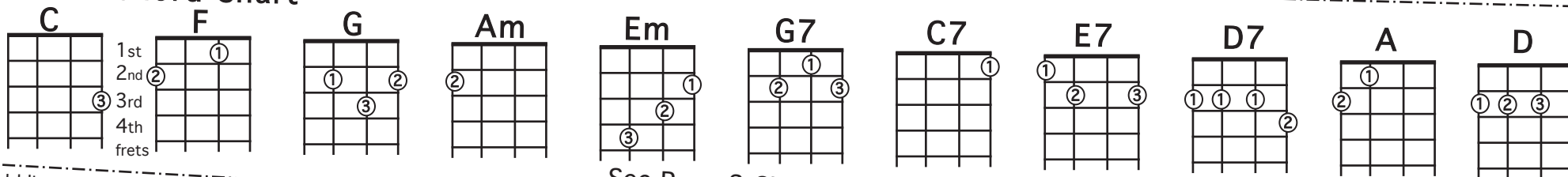
\* Fold dotted lines 1, 2, 3 & 4 under. Then fold dotted line 5 & dotted line 6 last.  
 To make ukulele neck firm, place cardboard ( 1 and 1/4 x 11 inches), a flat ruler, paint stick or craft sticks inside the fold lines

Review the names, numbers & location of ukulele strings & frets on the ukulele fretboard in the middle of this page.  
 (black dots indicate 5th,7th & 10th frets)

- ① = index/pointer 1st finger
- ② = middle 2nd finger
- ③ = ring 3rd finger
- ④ = pinky 4th finger

To form chords, Arch your fingers. Use Left Hand fingers tips to fret (press) the strings.  
 It may feel awkward but keep practicing! You will learn!
