To preserve actual size of ukulele neck, DO NOT reduce or enlarge when making copies. Use Landscape mode.

*Hint - Memorize strings & tuning for standard ukulele: **GCEA** Give Children Every Advantage

Learn the names, numbers & location of strings & frets by utilizing the Chord Charts on pages 1 & 3.

To play a chord, Arch your fingers. Use your Left Hand finger tips to fret (press) the strings. It may feel awkward but keep practicing! You will be developing *muscle memory* & **You will learn!**

C Chord

- 3rd finger on 3rd fret of A (1st) string
- Strum all four strings to play the C Chord

F Chord

- 1st finger on 1st fret of E (2nd) string.
- 2nd finger on 2nd fret of G (4th) string.
- Strum all four strings to play the F Chord

G Chord

- 1st finger on 2nd fret of C (3rd) string.
- 2nd finger on 2nd fret of A (1st) string.
- 3rd finger on 3rd fret of E (2nd) string.
- Strum all four strings to play the G Chord

To Change Keys (Sing in your comfort range)

	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8
Key of	C	D	E	F	G	A	B	C
Key of	G	A	B	C	D	E	F	G

To play single notes (melody/lead) on ukulele, see below

The first OPEN column is the note when string is strummed open (not fretted)

Refer to PIANO-FREE PRACTICE for reading music & melody notes.

OPEN	Ukulele	Fretboard	Notes
A	A#	B	C C# D
E	F	F#	G G# A
C	C#	D	D# E F
G	G#	A	A# B C

Each fret is going up one half note
